New Castle County Police Issues "Gold Alert"

Police Seek Missing Person

New Castle County Police are presently searching for **VERDE MCGANN**, a 74 year old female who resides in the unit block of Stardust Drive in the development of Melody Meadows.

(Newark, 19702) On May 15, 2015, New Castle County Police responded to the unit block of Stardust Drive for the report of missing person. Police were advised that Verde McGann left messages for her family that are causing a concern for her welfare. Verde was last seen leaving her residence today at approximately 5:45 pm by another family member. She has not been seen or heard from since. She left in her own vehicle which is described as follows: 2008 Buick Lacrosse tan in color, Delaware Registration 840642. Assisting officers checked the community and the surrounding areas including area motels on Route 40 in Elkton, MD. Their efforts were unsuccessful.

VERDE MCGANN is described as being a white female, 5' 07" tall, 140 lbs, with red hair, and blue eyes. She was last seen wearing a black and white tee shirt and black pants. Verde McGann has lived at this residence for one year and does not frequent any particular locations of interest.
