



NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR CDBG, CDBG-CV AND ESG-CV FUNDS FROM THE CARES ACT AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that New Castle County is proposing a Substantial Amendment (SA) to its 2019 Annual Action Plan to reallocate 2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and allocate CDBG-CV and ESG-CV funds awarded under the FY20 CARES Act supplemental funding legislation. The County expects to receive \$1,427,933 in CDBG-CV funds and \$690,366 in ESG-CV funds.

The purpose of the public hearing is to discuss the County's intent to allocate funds for activities for income-eligible households that have been directly impacted by Covid-19, including:

- (1) Reallocating \$250,000 from CDBG Program Delivery in the 2019 Annual Plan to Subsistence Payments.
- (2) Providing \$92,346 in CDBG-CV funds for Subsistence Payments

- (3) Providing \$731,218 in CDBG-CV funds for Hotel/Motel Vouchers
- (4) Providing \$50,000 in CDBG-CV funds for Health-Related Supportive Services
- (5) Providing \$100,000 in CDBG-CV funds for Legal Services
- (6) Providing \$285,586 in CDBG-CV funds for Program Administration
- (7) Providing \$372,797 in ESG-CV funds for Emergency Shelter Operations
- (8) Providing \$248,531 in ESG-CV funds for Rapid Re-Housing
- (9) Providing \$69,036 in ESG-CV funds for Program Administration

The City of Newark intends to allocate funds for activities for income-eligible households that have been directly impacted by Covid-19, including:

- (1) Providing \$118,147 in CDBG-CV funds for Subsistence Payments
- (2) Providing \$33,756 in CDBG-CV funds for Hotel/Motel Vouchers
- (3) Providing \$16,878 in CDBG-CV funds for Health-Related Supportive Services

The County will present the Draft SA to the New Castle County Commission on May 12, 2020 for action. The County intends to submit the approved SA to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on or about May 13, 2020.
