**NCCPD Investigates Home Invasion
in the Community of Tweedsmere, at Odessa National**

New Castle County Police are currently investigating a home invasion that occurred this afternoon at 12:36 p.m. in the community of Tweedsmere, at Odessa National, located in Townsend, DE.

(Townsend, DE. 19734) On Tuesday (5/27) afternoon, at 12:36 p.m., County Police responded to the 200 block of Aberdeen Way for a reported home invasion. When officers arrived, they learned that two unknown, black male suspects had entered the victim's residence. One of the intruders was armed with a handgun. During the altercation, the male victim was assaulted, and property was stolen from the residence.

The suspects are described as black males, in their twenties, 6 feet tall, average build, wearing dark clothing. Detectives are actively investigating the incident and are seeking assistance from the community to help identify the suspects.
