**UPDATE**

**Homicide Investigation,**  
**Woodland at St. George's**

The New Castle County Police, Criminal Investigations Unit has arrested **Temitope Adebamiro**, a 35-year-old female from the 1300 block of Healy Court in the Woodland at St. George's. She has been charged with murder in the first degree and other related charges following the death of her husband **Adeyinka Adebamiro**.

**(Bear, Del.-19701)** Early Thursday morning, New Castle County Police responded to the 1300 block of Healy Court for an unknown problem. Officers arrived at the home and located Adeyinka unconscious with an apparent stab wound to the upper body. The New Castle County Paramedics pronounced Adeyinka deceased at 1:37 a.m.

Officers transported the residents of the home to the Cpl. Paul J. Sweeney Public Safety Building where detectives later learned Adeyinka and Tempitope were engaged in a verbal argument. The investigation revealed the argument led to a physical altercation and Adeyinka was later found deceased. The Delaware Division of Forensic Science has ruled Adeyinka's death a homicide.

**Tempitope Adebamiro** was charged with murder in the first degree and possession of a weapon during the commission of a felony. She was arraigned and committed to the Delores J. Baylor Women's Correctional Institution where she is being held without bail.

**Death Investigation.**  
**Red Lion Chase**

The New Castle County Police are currently conducting a death investigation of a 37-year-old male in Red Lion Chase.

**(Bear, Del.-19701 )** On Thursday (4/23) at approximately 12:38 a.m., New Castle County Police were dispatched to the 1300 block of Healy Court in Red Lion Chase for an unknown problem. Officers then located the 37-year-old man in a bedroom. The New Castle County Paramedics were also called to the home and later pronounced the man deceased.
